Avoid gym shoes with black soles, zippers or those that slip on. Gym shoes can be old; they do not need to be new or expensive brands. Parents: **PLEASE** label all supplies with your child's name.

- **All Music classes:** pencils, box of Kleenex
- **Spanish 4 and 5:** quality English-Spanish/Spanish-English dictionary.
- **Spanish 5:** journal notebook
- With the block schedule students have **FOUR classes PER TERM (16 sections per year) and NEED TO HAVE ample folders, pens/pencils, and notebooks and paper.**

Seniors for the 2016-2017 school year should schedule their appointments for senior portraits between May-August if they want the portrait completed in time for inclusion in the school yearbook. Senior pictures are due to the yearbook advisor by Oct 1, 2016.
