

Blood Borne Pathogen Training Instructions

The Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) is a federal organization within the Department of Labor, which ensures safe and healthy working conditions. OSHA requires that each employee complete Blood Borne Pathogen Training on an annual basis. The Howards Grove School District administers this training each fall through a module prepared and provided by the Wisconsin Department of Education.

Target Audience: school nurses, teachers, para educators, secretaries, administrators, school first aid responders, coaches, and other school staff

Time it takes to complete the training: 20 minutes

Instructions: Follow the link below to view the entire module. At the end of the module after completing all sections and completing the quiz, enter Sharry Ringmeier's email, sringmeier@hgsd.k12.wi.us, then complete the form with your first and last name and other contact info.
